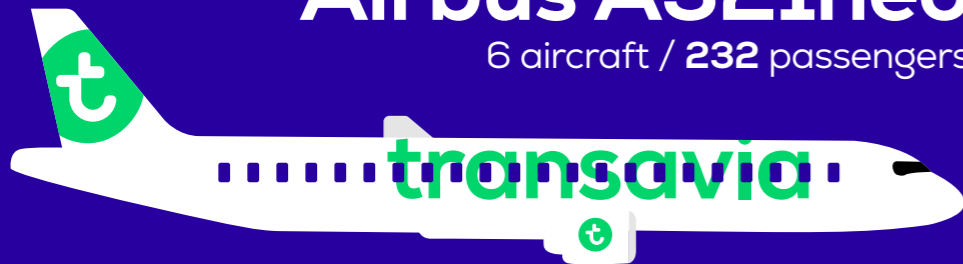


Transavia France was founded in 2006 and has 4 bases: Paris-Orly, Nantes, Lyon and Montpellier.

## Airbus A321neo

6 aircraft / 232 passengers



We will replace all current Boeing aircraft within the next seven years with new Airbus aircraft, specifically the **A320neo** and **A321neo**. In doing so, we are working towards **cleaner, quieter, and more fuel-efficient aviation**. On 5 January 2024, we flew for the first time with the new A321neo (PH-YHZ).

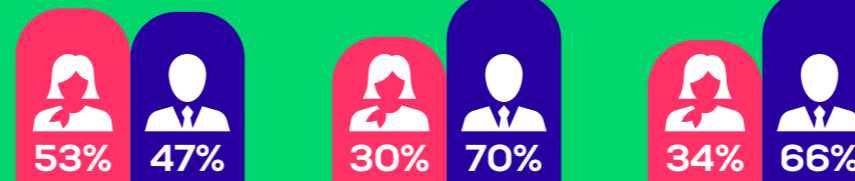
